



## "Best Practices" - Battery Box Latch Maintenance

There is one particular latch on the outside of the bus that may not be getting the necessary maintenance.





It is strongly recommended that at every "30 Day Maintenance" that some spray lubricant be used on the latch to maintain it in its working environment.

With a **NEW** bus, if this latch is defective, the replacement of it is considered a "Warranty" failure.

If a running unit is not maintained, its failure is considered a "lack of maintenance" by the factory and is not considered as a warranty situation.

The used latches shown above were both seized, the left one was successfully cleaned with spray penetrating oil and works fine. A steam cleaner may also be helpful in cleaning a seized unit prior to lubrication.
